- Provides students with a mechanism to reach out to adults and report problems anonymously.
- Builds positive connections between students and faculty members.
- Resolves student problems in a safe, efficient and timely manner.
- Allow students to assist in creating and maintaining a safe school environment.
- Provides broadcast notification to students, staff and parents when critical information needs to be shared instantly.

Today, thousands of students in more than 300 elementary, middle and high schools across the United States rely on AnComm's 'Talk About It' to report problems and incidents ranging from bullying, gangs, threats of violence, suicide and cheating to drug and alcohol abuse, depression, stress, and physical abuse.
